2025 Corporate Cup Rules

PLAYERS PLEASE NOTE:

NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED ON THE GREENS.

SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED WITHIN THE CLUB'S BOUNDARY.

SMOKING AREAS ARE OUTSIDE CRAMER STREET ENTRANCE AND THE TWO GATES ON THE ALBERT PARK SIDE OF THE GREENS.

NO SMOKING THROUGH EMERGENCY DOOR INTO CROQUET CLUB

- 1. Play commences at 6.00pm. Players to be present by 5:45pm, if possible.**
- 2. ONLY ONE PAST OR PRESENT PENNANT PLAYER PER TEAM AND THEY MUST PLAY AS THE SECOND (Current 1st year pennant players are exempt).**
- 3. We encourage each team to have at least 1 player, new to bowls**
- 4. NO DRIVING - FAST BOWLS**
- 5. No dead ends (when the Jack has been knocked out of bounds) Jack is to be re-spotted on the centre T.**
- 6. Flat soled shoes (or barefoot) must be worn on the greens.**
- 7. Teams are to consist of 4 players, 2 bowls per player.**
- 8. Substitutes are permitted weekly. If missing a player, the lead has an extra 2 bowls as the third.**
- 9. The Corporate Cup will run for 6 weeks, February through to March.**
- 10. Weather permitting, 12 ends shall be played each week.**
- 11. If there is a likelihood of severe weather, all team will play 6 ends under the dome. The teams drawn to play under the dome will play first, the other teams will be reallocated rinks numbers and play second.**
- 12. Weekly Prizes & Raffles - Must be present to win**
- 13. Winners will be decided on highest number of points.**
- 14. The top 4 teams will play off for positions 1 to 3 on the last round.**
- 15. In the event of a draw, the winners will be decided by the highest number of ends won. All players are to have their names, telephone numbers & email addresses listed on the entry form.**
- 16. No competitor information shall be given to third parties.**
- 17. Any issues are to be directed to the Corporate Cup Officials, their decision is final.**
